Dear Parents/Carers,

It was so lovely to meet so many of you at our welcome evening. I do hope that you now have a good understanding of what we are doing in year 4. We are now working hard to get our assembly organized for next Friday. For our opening number it would be fabulous if the children could be wearing something with sequins or sparkle. Otherwise a plain t-shirt (P.E. t-shirt) would be fine. If any of you have any feather boas or glittery headwear which would add to the look it would be much appreciated. Your child should have brought home the words to the song we are learning. It would be great if these could be learnt as well as learning a line or two for the performance.

English: We have been continuing with our work on fables. The children looked at the characters from the fables we have been looking at and picked out their character traits such as noticing that the fox was cunning and sly. We have also been focusing on using conjunctions in our grammar work. For spelling the children are learning prefixes and we have been practising these in class.

Maths: We have been developing our understanding of mental addition and subtraction by adding and subtracting pairs of two-digit or three-digit numbers. We have been thinking about which method works best, counting up or counting back. The children have gone on to practise and apply their knowledge through a variety of reasoning and problem solving problems.

Other Subjects In Science, the children had a brilliant time exploring the electrical components and equipment to see how to put together circuits. They tested bulbs, motors and buzzers and then recorded their observations. In enrichment we have been continuing our learning by finding out about the invention of the motor car. We looked at how the design of cars has changed through time. We then placed them in chronological order on a timeline.
