English: We have begun the term by writing about our summer holiday. The children had the opportunity to have a chat with a partner about what they had got up to before writing a draft. We then continued with our writing making improvements to make it the best it could be. Checking capital letters and punctuation; fabulous word choices were all ways in which we up levelled our work. I have been very impressed with the work that was produced.

Maths: In maths, the children have been exploring four digit numbers. We have been investigating how many different ways we can arrange four numbers. This was many more than we thought possible! We have also explored what happens when we change a digit in a four digit number to zero and comparing pairs of four digit numbers using < and >.
