


Class Cherry Weekly Review

English

This week we started a new unit on instructions. The children have worked well to identify the language and structural features of this text. We have spent time analysing examples of instructions and have also had fun following instructions on drawing faces and making paper lilies.

Maths

In Maths we started a new unit on addition and subtraction. We have revised the formal written column method for addition and subtraction and identified misconceptions raised. We are also developing mental math strategies to improve speed and accuracy.

Science

In Science we continued with our topic on forces and looked at examples of electrical conductors and insulators by testing simple circuits.

Enrichment

This week we have been studying what life was like for people living in Ancient Egypt. We looked at typical jobs people carried out, learnt about what they ate and what they wore and also watched videos about the homes they lived in.
