English

In English this week, the children have continued to edit and polish their instructional texts, ensuring all of the key features including some fantastic technical language, use of imperative and adverbials are evident throughout. The children have also applied their understanding of parentheses to add extra information and detail to their writing.

Maths

We have been revising our multiplication and division skills this week, with a strong focus on solving word problems. The children have consolidated short multiplication written method and compared grid method and long multiplication for multiplying by 2 digit multipliers. In Arithmetic, we have consolidated place value in multiplication and division and looked at squared and prime numbers.

P.S.H.E.

After a wonderful visit to Ely Cathedral last week, the children have continued to explore the Remembrance theme. We have learned a little bit about World War 1 and about life as a soldier. We also looked at why poppies are the symbol of remembrance. Using some reproductions of photographs of the trenches, the children wrote about the War from the soldiers' perspective.

Religious Education

The children have been learning how Christians might view the Bible as a handbook, through some of the parables that Jesus used to illustrate his teachings. They have produced some lovely comic strips retelling some of the more famous parables.
