English

In English this week, we have worked on completing our instructional writing. We focused carefully on how to craft an introduction, using technical language and a range of punctuation to add pace and interest. We will then be moving on to create specific instructions on how to operate the futuristic vehicles we have designed. We have continued to focus on grammar and looked at modal verbs.

Maths

This week, children have worked on negative numbers and place value. They have revised how to order negative and positive numbers, calculated with them and compared them.

Enrichment

In Enrichment, we have been learning about the symbolism and structure of the Egyptian pyramids. Children found out what objects were buried in pyramids with pharaohs and learnt about how the Egyptians believed that whatever was entombed would join them in the afterlife. Children then created triaramas (3D pyramids) and decorated them accordingly. They then completed in-depth research and created a factual text to explain the different features of an Egyptian tomb.

Ely Cathedral

Children enjoyed their trip this week to Ely Cathedral where they learnt all about the importance about remembering World War I. There were several workshops and a theatre performance! The day ended with a memorial service during which poppies rained down on the congregation!
