Dear Parents/Carers,

The Harvest Festival service was lovely today. The children have worked very hard to learn their verse of our poem about peace.

**English:** In English this week, we have done a cold write about a member of our family. We have also been linking to our work in enrichment by looking at the theme of inventions and how they have changed people's lives. Our grammar work has been focusing on verb tenses. We have also been doing some guided reading by answering questions on a text that we have read together. Our reading diaries should be written in at least three times every week and reflect what we have read.

**Maths:** We have been learning how to use a compass. We learnt the new words of circumference and diameter. It would be good to practice drawing circles at home with a compass as it's quite a challenge. We have also been naming, sorting and describing 2D and 3D shapes. We used Venn and Carroll diagrams to sort our shapes. We discovered that triangles have names; isosceles, equilateral and scalene. We talked about the differences between them and their properties.

**Other Subjects** In Science, the children went on a 'switch' hunt around the school. We discovered all the different types of switches. We then had to choose from a range of equipment to make our own switch and put it into a circuit. In Enrichment this week, we have been learning about the inventor Leonardo Da Vinci. We looked at his designs of different types of transport before having a go at sketching and making our own.
