In English this week we have looked at sentence construction and studied how to retell a familiar story using story maps. Mrs McKeever taught an exciting lesson about nouns and adjectives during which we went out onto the playground and made sentences with our words.

As part of our Maths lessons we have read different calculations and decided what actions were needed to solve word problems. The children have explored various ways of reaching the answers using apparatus and individual whiteboards for calculations as well as creating their own number lines. We visited the Nature Reserve and collected leaves, small twigs and seeds which we then used for practical maths calculations.

Weather continues to be our focus in Science and we have begun recording the weather and temperature in our weather diaries. It has been wonderful to make the most of glorious warm days this week and we have enjoyed taking our learning outside the classroom.
