Curriculum News

In Maths, we have been working with addition and subtraction. The children have been introduced to the vocabulary of 'addition', 'subtraction', 'plus' and 'minus.' We have used counters and cubes to work out the answers and the children have also started using a Numberline to help with addition and subtraction calculations. In RE we are learning about Christianity this term and we have been looking at the account of the Creation in the Bible and have made group collages of the events of each day. In English, the children found key skills in a description and were introduced to different parts of speech.
