NOTES FROM THE TEACHERS

English

This week we began our new unit on classic literature in English, studying 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C. S. Lewis. The children have shown much interest in the story and have produced a diary entry as the character of Lucy about her adventures at the start of the story.

Maths

In Maths we have learned how to find factors of a target number and have identified common factors and highest common factors in different target numbers. We have also found all prime numbers under 100 and tested theories about prime numbers. We also measured the perimeter of composite, rectilinear shapes (ask them what that means!)

Enrichment

The children are enjoying making their Ancient Egypt mummies at the moment. After making mummies from clay and wrapping up their model with bandages, they are now designing and making their own sarcophagus cases to put their mummies in.
