English

This week we have continued to read 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C. S. Lewis. The children are starting to prepare to write a description of a wintry scene, so this week we have been creating thought showers and thinking about adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

Maths

In Maths we have been learning about square numbers and cubed numbers. The children have been able to find all square numbers up to 12x12 and have solved various problems regarding square numbers and prime numbers. We have also looked at the area of rectilinear, compound shapes.

Enrichment

This week in Enrichment the children have been learning about gods and goddesses in Ancient Egyptian times. They have learnt about the powers and features of some of the key gods and created an information table on them. As an extension, the children made their own top trump card games based on these gods.
