Hazel class have been revisiting Place Value this week and we have started to look at word problems, this is an area we will be revisiting throughout the year so the children can get used to this format of questioning.

In English we have written our hot task of writing a story in a familiar setting. For this task we are looking at the use of common punctuation including apostrophes and commas in their work. We have also continued to look at the use of adjectives and adverbs in our work. The children are steadily getting a lot better with this. Again this is something we will revisit throughout the year.

Our enrichment topic has seen us present our castles to each other this week. The children have really enjoyed this project and we have been so impressed with the efforts and quality of the projects.
