English

In English this week, the children have continued their work on crime and punishment. We looked at the most common crimes in the Middle Ages and how the community were involved in the punishment of offenders. We annotated an old, metaphorical image, which told the story of how criminals were dealt with. We also looked at the legend of Robin Hood and how he became an outlaw. Children then used this information to create a detailed 'Wanted' poster, describing the physical attributes of Robin Hood and biographical information to aid his capture!

Maths

In Maths this week we have continued to work on our division skills. The children are gaining confidence with the DMSP (divide, multiply, subtract and pull down) method for long division. The children have also developed their knowledge of fraction and percentage equivalents and how to find simple percentages of amounts.

Computing

In Computing this week, children have developed their knowledge of spreadsheets. We worked on how to create formulae to complete mathematical operations involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children completed a range of calculations after creating their own spreadsheets and writing their own formulae.
