We have had our usual busy week. We are enjoying learning our songs for the Christmas production, hopefully the words have come home so they can be practiced. Reminder about bringing in items for our class luxury hamper for Christmas Capers.

English: We have been continuing to look at the books of Horrid Henry. We started the week by thinking of questions to ask Henry. Some volunteers took on the role of Henry to think of answers to these questions. We have also been applying our grammar learning of using fronted adverbials to write descriptive sentences. The week finished with us doing a 'Hot Write' to write our own Horrid Henry story.

Maths: This week we have been concentrating on subtracting 3-digit numbers using expanded decomposition. The children have really enjoyed this method and it would be great if they could share this learning with you. We are also continuing to focus on times tables with the addition of the 3 and 4 times table.

Other Subjects The children are really enjoying our learning about sound. This week we looked at sound waves by using a tuning fork and rice bouncing on a drum. The children then made telephones to begin to identify how sound is made and travels to the ear. In our enrichment work we looked at the invention of the telephone by Alexander Graham Bell and we continued with our fabulous presentations.
