Dear Parents/Carers,

We are beginning our Christmas play rehearsals. It's great to see how many children have already learnt the words. Costume wise we would like all children to wear a Christmas jumper/t-shirt. The children that are the T.A.'s to wear 'smart' adult like clothing and an apron. If anyone has any 'chef type' clothing for two children that would also be appreciated.

Just a reminder that maths homework is due in on Tuesdays and English on a Friday. We have quite a few children not bringing their homework in on the correct day.

A lot of the children have been bringing in pencil cases. Unfortunately the contents (smelly pencils, rubbers and squishes) have caused quite a few issues and have been a distraction.

Therefore children will no longer be able to have them in the classroom.

English: The children are in the stages of writing up information texts about a type of drum called a tabla. We have been collecting our facts and thinking carefully how to arrange them into paragraphs. In our grammar work we have continued to think about use of conjunctions and we have been looking at how apostrophes show possession.

Maths: We have been visiting arrays (rectangle numbers) to reinforce factors and multiples as well as to develop their understanding of the connection between multiplication's different laws. We have been doing lots of investigative work where we have been having to explaining our thinking. We are all working hard on our 2, 5, 10, 3 & 4 times table facts.

Other Subjects We have started a new computing topic to learn about word processing. We started this week by being able to change font, size and colour of type. In Science, the children have been learning about how we and animals hear. In enrichment we have been reflecting upon the inventors that we have studied and thinking about which invention we think is the most important.
