




# Cedar's Weekly Review

This morning we had our sporting achievements assembly and enjoyed hearing all about the exciting clubs our children are involved with.



It was fantastic to see the variety of sporting activities the children engage in and I was very impressed to find out just how many awards and medals they have already won. However, participating in sport isn't all about awards, there are so many health benefits and invaluable skills to be gained through participation in sport it was wonderful to see just how much sporting interest there is in the school and enjoy a snippet of their involvement in today's assembly.

## Maths

This week maths has been all about length, weight and handling data. We have used metre rules for measuring the length of items in the classroom in m and cm, and we measured our heights. We have used rulers for measuring the length of our feet in cm and mm and we have weighed many different items in the classroom in g and kg including our weights. The children successfully collated their results into tables and bar charts and were able to answer questions and interpret the data correctly.

## English

We have worked hard on our grammar this week. The children have been learning to incorporate a variety of adverbs and adverbial phrases into their own writing that describe time, place and manner. We have been reading 'The diary of a Lively Labrador' and practising our past tenses in preparation for the children to plan and write their own recount of a diary entry.

## Art

I have been sharing some Lowry artwork with the class this term and we have focussed our attention on appreciating his style, use of colours, street perspectives and the way he draws and paints people. The children practised drawing their own stick figures, trying to incorporate movement into them, and then built them up and put them into their own Lowry style painting of my school sketch.
