English

This week the children carried out a reading comprehension activity, studying a balanced argument. This week the children also revised the rules for using a comma in writing. We focused on the incorrect use of commas between independent clauses (known as a comma splice) and corrected examples.

Maths

In Maths, the children have continued with their fraction unit by adding and subtracting fractions and then moved onto multiplying fractions by a whole number.

Enrichment
