## NOTES FROM THE TEACHERS

We had a busy Tuesday this week in Cherry class! The children enjoyed visiting the church on Tuesday morning for the Easter Experience. They rotated around different stations in the church to learn more about the Easter story. On returning to school, the children designed and made their own miniature eggs, based on the work of Carl Faberge.

On Tuesday afternoon, the children also took part in a science 'live lesson' with the BBC, learning more about our oceans and the environmental concerns they face. This was a fantastic opportunity for the children ahead of learning about habitats in Science next term.

### English

In English, the children have started to learn about explanation texts. The pupils analysed the structural and language features of explanation texts from studying a range of examples and carried out a reading comprehension task on an explanation text about deforestation. They children have also developed their knowledge of cause and effect language.

### Maths

In Maths, the children have been carrying out a range of assessments to monitor their progress. This included a hot task to end the fraction unit, an end of term reasoning paper and a cold task on the new decimals and percentages unit.

### Science

In the live lesson online, the children learnt about the environmental disasters facing our oceans. They looked at the impacts of plastic pollution, global warming and overfishing on sea life and found out about what we can do in our own lives to reduce these devastating consequences.
