Curriculum News 5

Last week we finished our Maths unit looking at properties of shapes. We have now moved into Statistics where the children have been looking at tally charts and pictograms and how to decipher information from them. The children have picked this up quite quickly, which is pleasing to see.

In English, we have begun work on a unit that encompasses diary writing and writing from the point of view of a character. The children are using what they have learned with regards to writing in the 1st person, using time connectives and ensuring the details are in chronological order. This unit is enabling us to revisit some of the skills we have learned and further applying them to our work.

Science has seen us take an introductory look at life process' and habitats for living creatures, which is something we will look at more in depth after the Easter break.
