This week has been science week and this has well and truly been embraced in Rosewood. Tim from Air Space launched our Science week last Friday by talking to the children about satellites. The children then worked in groups to make rockets, which we launched across the classroom. A fun start!

Monday saw us thinking about air. The children worked as a team to make a windmill. It took many adjustments to the design to get the windmill to spin but we all felt very proud of our final result. We then carried out an investigation to prove that air has weight using balloons.

Tuesday was an assembly by 'Mad Science'. The children enjoyed seeing reactions from mixing substances together. We also had a visit from Sabrina and Jessica from Abbexa who talked about cells and proteins.

The week continued with Richard from Anglian Water on Wednesday morning. We had a great time discovering where water comes from, uses of water and how we can be more mindful of our usage. The children also really enjoyed learning about **sewage!** Each group had a container that they added various 'ingredients' to, to show what happened to items we flush down the toilet or put down the sink.

The rest of science week has been an opportunity for the children to develop their teamwork skills whilst working on science investigations such as: - what can water dissolve? Viscosity of liquids, cornflour gloop and what happens to the ice hands?
