English:

Maths:

In Maths, we have been concentrating on written methods for addition and subtraction. We are now able to use compact addition to add three digit numbers and add amounts of money. We are continuing to practise using expanded and compact decomposition for subtraction of three digit numbers.

Other Subjects:

We have spent a lot of our time this week focused on the Easter Story. We had a lovely morning at church doing a carousel of activities to learn about each aspect of Easter Week. We followed this up at school by decorating an egg in the style of Faberge.
