Curriculum News



In Maths we have finished our mini topic on multiplication and division and will return to it at a later date. We have now begun thinking about measurement, using standard and non-standard methods for measuring items. We have enjoyed more Storytime phonics activities too which is certainly helping sound recognition and alternate spellings for the same sounds.



In Enrichment/Science we looked at how penguins stay warm and dry. We used wax crayons to colour one penguin and then drop water onto the plain penguin and then the coloured one. We discovered that the water ran off the crayoned penguin. We used our sense of smell to try smells in covered pots. It was certainly harder than it looked!
