

Curriculum News

In English the children have written sentences using the word 'and' as well as focussing on aspects of the Jim and the Beanstalk story. The children wrote letters to Jim, learning how to set out a letter and they worked hard to include capital letters and full stops in the correct places. We have been reminding them to read through their writing to check that it makes sense and that they haven't missed out any words. Instead of Music this week, Mrs Wheatman introduced the class to some of the work of famous artists and the children explored with pastels on paper.


