Maths

In maths we have been reviewing our learning so far this year. We have also been working in teams to use a range of maths skills to try to solve the 'Murder mystery at the movies'. Please continue to practice times tables over half term.

Other Subjects

In Enrichment, the children have enjoyed continuing to be like Stone Age people by making a tool or weapon to help when hunting. The children looked at a range of Stone Age tools before deciding which one they would like to make. We spent some time gathering our materials and then using a range of equipment to make our implement.

In Science, we have been learning how to use criteria to sort plants and animals. The children worked in groups to devise a classification key.

In RE, we are continuing to explore the religion of Judaism. This week we were looking at what places are special to Jewish people; exploring Jerusalem and The Synagogue.
