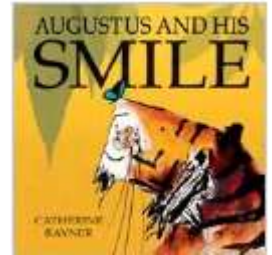

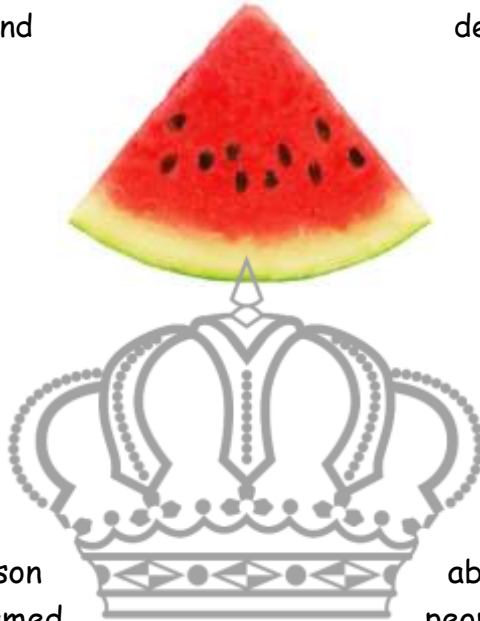
Curriculum News
