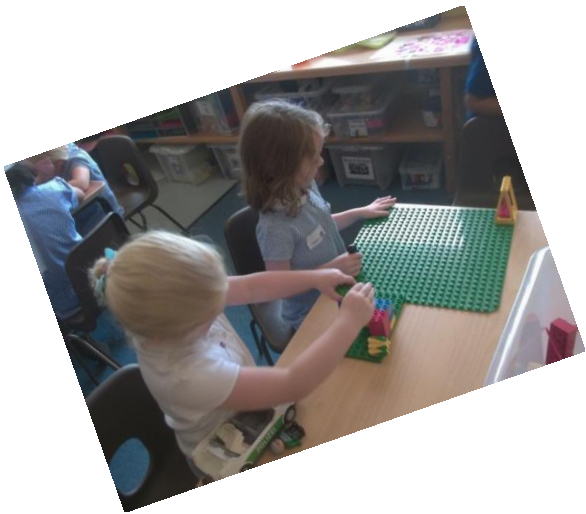


Moving on up!
