Maths

The children have had a great first week back at school and have enjoyed a full week of 'inspirational Maths', starting each lesson with a mindset boosting video and working collaboratively on an inspirational hands-on Maths activity. We have started by looking at place value of numbers up to one hundred.

English

We have started our unit on Writing to Entertain this week and have been reading 'I'll take you to Mrs Coles' by Michael Foreman. The children have been learning how to use powerful verbs in their writing and how to use conjunctions for time, place and cause.

History

We have started our topic on the Anglo-Saxons and the children enjoyed taking part in a treasure hunt in the school field looking for clues written in Runes.
