Maths

We have been continuing with addition this week, this time by drawing number lines. The children have learnt to start with the biggest number and then make jumps along the line starting by adding to the next ten using their knowledge of number bonds. They have been using number lines to solve word problems involving addition up to 3 digit numbers.

English

We have been looking at performance poetry this week. We have read 'The Bug Chant' and the children memorised different stanzas of the poem and performed them to the rest of the class with actions. We worked on expression and delivery to perform our poetry well. We also read 'The Lone Dog' by Irene McCloud and the children have been learning how to use a dictionary to look up unknown words. This is an important skill to master so please do encourage them to use a dictionary next time they want to find the meaning of unknown words.

Science

We have been looking at teeth and their role in digestion. The children have been learning about the different types of teeth and how these are structured to cope with different kinds of food. I challenged the children to identify skulls of various kinds of herbivores, carnivores and omnivores by their set of teeth.

I hope you all enjoyed the community poetry assembly today. I was so impressed with how well the children performed their poems and how many words some of them had remembered. I really enjoyed listening to them and seeing the enthusiasm they put into their performance. Thank you for supporting them with this.
