

# Weekly Review – Cedar Class

## Maths

We have been reinforcing our understanding of subtraction this week by doing subtraction sums using place value (e.g.  $267-2$ ,  $267-60$  and  $267-200$ ) and then working out how to make one of the digits in our number change by writing the correct sum (e.g. make the 2 change into an 8:  $267+600=867$ ). The children checked their answers using a calculator and seeing whether the right digit changed.

## English

We have been working on past and present tense this week and looking at how the endings of regular verbs change as we change to past tense. The children have also been matching up irregular verbs into their past and present forms.

## Art

We talked about autumn colours and the colours that we could see on our landscape at this time of year. The children used the pencil sketch of their landscape from last week to paint an autumnal landscape using watercolours.

## Science

We have been looking at what forces are at work in different sports. The children worked in groups to mime their sport to the rest of the class and then explained to them what different forces are at work whilst playing the sport.

It was lovely to catch up with you all at the parent's evenings this week and finally put faces to all the names. Thank you for turning out and taking the time to discuss your child's progress with me.
