In Maths this week we have been looking at different ways to solve multiplication questions, practised our times tables skills on Times Tables Rock Stars (online) and begun looking at what multiples are. The children were excellent at spotting patterns and investigation the questions: 'is every multiple of 8 a multiple of 4, and every multiple of 4 a multiple of 8?'

With Mrs Faulkner we have started to measure the perimeter of composite shapes (2 shapes together).

In English, we have started *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*. We have read to chapter 3 and looked closely at some of the language used in the book. We imagined we were Lucy and wrote a diary entry about how we stumbled in the mysterious world of Narnia.

In Science we have been looking at saturated solutions and investigating them. We have learnt how solids, liquids and gases are chemically made up and how they behave when they are mixed.

It has become apparent that some children are more confident in their times tables knowledge than others. Please encourage your child to practise these at home, through games, quick fire questions, online activities (like Times Tables Rock Stars) and Purple Mash games. This is crucial for their current and adult life.
