Matha

We have been learning to add and subtract multiples of 100 this week and we have been looking at helpful ways to do this mentally. The children have then worked on a series of calculations and varied fluency problems adding and subtracting in multiples of 100.

<u>English</u>

We have been discussing the features of recounts (first person, past tense, chronological order, speech marks for spoken word etc...) and looking at what a good example of a recount looks like. We woked together to identify and underlined the features in the extract then found an article in the newspaper that intreseted them and tried to identify all of the same features correctly in the article.

Science

We have been looking at magnets and their magnetic field this week and learning how magnets use their force to attract certain objects towards them. The children went on a tour of the school looking for objects that the magnet would attract and those that it would not, and they grouped them as magnetic or non-magnetic. We then looked at what materials are magnetic.
