Friday 31st January 2020




In Maths this week we have been looking at statistics - what information can we get from different graphs/charts/tables? Firstly, we looked at tally charts and what the data shows.



This is a very quick and clever way of representing 17. We did our own class surveys and displayed the votes in this way.

Then we looked at pictograms. We saw how one picture could mean different amounts:



Here, each fruit is worth 1.



Here, each fruit is worth 2. We were able to answer lots of questions about the information in a pictogram.

In English, we have been writing Adventure stories. The children have been writing in the role of Carl Fredrickson who is going on an expedition to Paradise Falls with the famous explorer Beatrice T Brave! The style of the story is based on the film, 'Up' and Carl's house was lifted into the air by hundreds of helium balloons. They had to create a 'Complication', a 'Resolution' and then an 'Ending'. They have been using powerful adjectives in noun phrases, exciting adverbs for action words, superb conjunctions to join their ideas and great adventure vocabulary. I hope they share their story ideas with you at home!



In Science, we have been learning about Healthy Eating. We explored a 'balanced diet' and learnt about the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of foods. They know which foods are healthy and which are less healthy.

They have designed their own daily healthy food meal plan so they might let you know their preferences - be warned!

In PSHE we enjoyed learning about families and we discussed how each family is different. They really enjoyed drawing pictures of who is in their family and sharing with the class why their family is special. We respected each other's views, similarities and differences.
