

The children also enjoyed reasoning tasks and worked out possible answers to calculations but were also required to prove how they reached the answers. The children produced some wonderful close observational drawings of plants in Art. In English we have started to recognise nouns and adjectives and the children highlighted them in an extract from our class book 'The Enchanted Land.' They are becoming more confident when spelling their common exception words but please continue to practise these at home.
