English

In English this week, we have started a new unit on writing to entertain and we have begun reading *Fantastic Mr Fox*. The children were asked to do a bit of drama to summarise the story so far and to try to bring the characters to life. This proved quite a challenge. I think the children need a little more drama practice! They looked at words and phrases in the story that described the characters and then wrote character descriptions using some of their words and descriptive phrases.

Maths

The children have really impressed me with their knowledge and understanding of measurement this week. They have answered some tricky word problems on mass, and completed numbers sentences using combinations of units of weight.

History

The children are certainly learning a lot about Egypt this term. They have found out about the dates of some of the key events in the history of Ancient Egypt and completed a timeline to document some of these like the first pyramid and the start of the rule of King Tut.
