


# Weekly Review - Hazel Class

## Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2020



This week we celebrated World Book Week, focusing on Alice in Wonderland - the children all looked fabulous on Thursday, thank you for all your effort to get them in the Alice in Wonderland spirit!

This week in Maths we have been looking at multiplication and division. We have practised lots of methods for division, including grouping, repeated addition, part-whole methods and bar diagrams.



We also enjoyed practising our times tables by covering the playground with number sentences in chalk!

In English, we looked at the story of Alice in Wonderland and focused on effective descriptions when she was looking into the rabbit hole and when she fell down to the bottom seeing lots of strange and wonderful things. We worked to edit our writing by adding fronted adverbials (sentence starters), conjunctions and exciting adjectives to keep the reader engaged. We also thought about what we might have seen if we were to have fallen down the rabbit hole ourselves....



On Monday we had a visit from two Cambridge United players who led a fantastic assembly on their 'Kick It Out' campaign to highlight what we can do to avoid discrimination, both in school and out.

Their activities and explanations to the children were really effective and there were some very thoughtful contributions from the children to support the campaign.
