RE

In RE this week the children have looked at the Gospel of Luke to unpick the events that happened to Jesus on which Easter is based. They have been thinking about the evidence that supports the Christian belief that Jesus was resurrected and what this means to them.

ENGLISH and SPANISH

In English this week, we have focused on elements of Alice in Wonderland. At the beginning of the week, we looked at extracts from the text and discussed vocabulary and authorial intent during guided reading. In other lessons, we looked at the scene when Alice fell down the rabbit hole. We collated some excellent vocabulary and wrote two short paragraphs as a first-person narrative.

MATHS

We have learned how to express linear sequences (pattern shapes and number sequences) as algebraic fractions in order to determine later parts of the sequence. The children have played around with algebraic expressions creating their own and then making patterns and number sequences based on them in order to better understand how they work.

It's been another exciting week at Bourn! The children have enjoyed learning about Alice in Wonderland during Book Week. We saw some fantastic costumes on Thursday. Then on Friday, we celebrated the life and work of Stephen Hawking on our House Day, by learning about his life and looking at Black Holes! We have even more exciting activities and visitors planned in our Science Week beginning on Monday.
