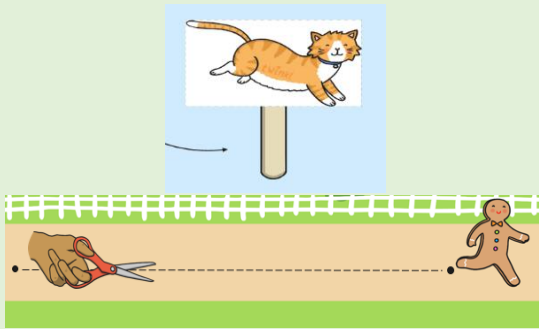




# Weekly Review – Willow Class
