Aspire at Romsey Mill supports children and young people in Cambridge city and South Cambridgeshire who have a diagnosed autism spectrum condition, and who are in mainstream education.

We run weekly after-school and evening youth clubs which provide a safe, supported, social space where children and young people with autism can make friends and enjoy youth club activities such as games, crafts, Lego, sports and games console.

We have youth clubs for children and young people (including groups specifically for girls) from school year 5, up to age 18 in locations in Cambridge city, Cambourne, and Linton (from late 2019)
