Please ensure a water bottle is brought in, as well as a waterproof for wet playtimes.

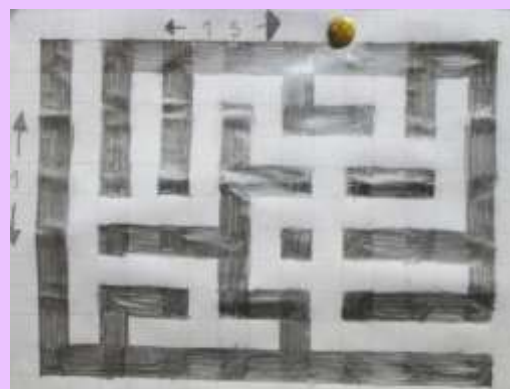
HOW YOU CAN HELP:
