Have a conversation about what they are learning.

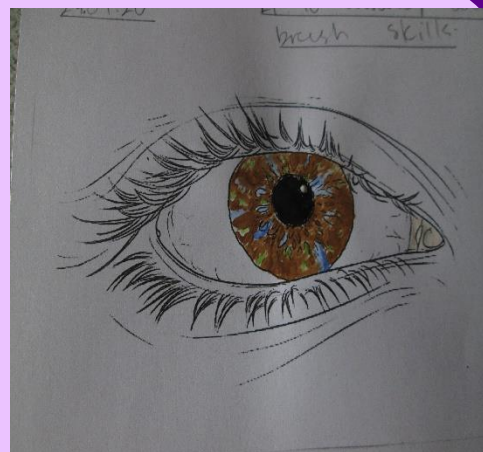
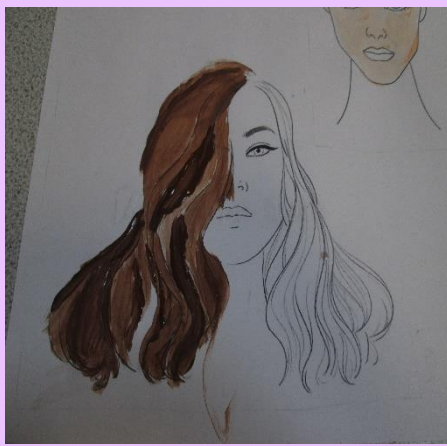
Encourage your child to read around topics they are learning at school.
