THIS WEEK

We have been looking at more poetry this week (The Lone Dog, The Bug chant, Wind Poems). The children learnt different stanzas of the Bug Chant and did a class performance from memory. They have also been writing some of their own poems. In Maths we have been expanding our understanding of addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers, paying particular attention to part whole models and number bonds. The children have drawn timelines in History to show the 3 different eras of the Stone Age and they have been critiquing each other's artwork to improve their drawings of a bison.

NEXT WEEK

We will be continuing to expand our understanding of addition and subtraction in Maths by looking at different ways of tackling addition sums (number bonds, number lines, and column method). In English we will be exploring verbs and adverbs in two new poems.

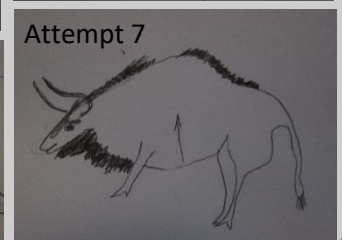
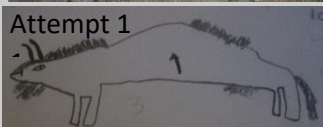
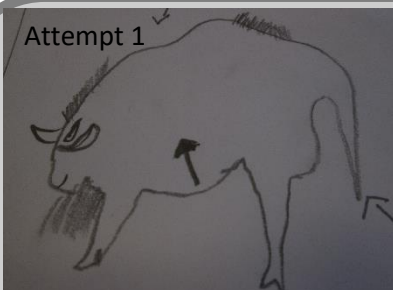
