THIS WEEK

This week we have continued with Instructions in English. We have written instructions for how to wash our hands properly and how to make a sandwich. Why not see if the children can do this at home?

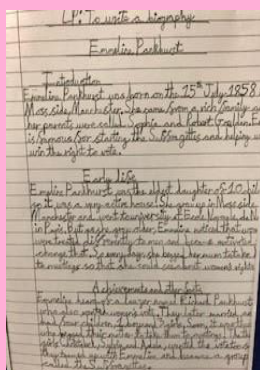
In Maths we have been looking at addition, using the column method and with exchange.

We have also been learning how to sketch different textures in preparation for our final landscape picture, that we will draw in Art next week. It would be useful for the children to look at some landscape photos or pictures that you may have at home.

In English next week, we will be looking at News reports and headlines. We know that less and less people are reading newspapers now, however reports online are particularly relevant now. We will look at the difference between facts and opinions and how we cannot always believe everything we read!

In Maths, we will go on to subtraction. We will be using all the vocabulary associated with subtraction, such as minus, less than, difference, deduct, take-away. We will also experiment with the fact that addition and subtraction are opposite operations and can be used to check answers. Then we will round answers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

In Science we will be looking at the effect climate change has on our habitats and conservation efforts for protected species.
