Extending learning at home....

The children have been given some Science topic ideas which they can work on over the next few weeks. Any work (including Maths and English) can be put in the book and we will collect them in after half term.

Home learning: This week please go through number bonds to 10 systematically with your child ($0+10=10$, $1+9=10$, $2+8=10$ etc) We have looked at the addition and equals sign as well as reminding ourselves about the greater than and less than signs which still can cause confusion! We often take it for granted that the children understand the Maths language of more/greater/bigger and less/smaller than which needs to be covered again and again with examples of less than /greater than numbers.

In RE we have continued to think about the Creation and also the importance of caring for plants and animals. The children created playdough creatures and then destroyed one of them which made them feel unhappy.
