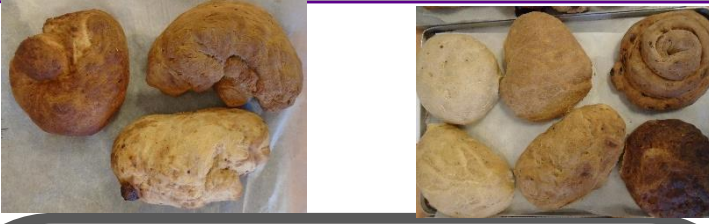


# Weekly Review – Cedar Class
