THIS WEEK

The children have really impressed us with their recall of the different classes of vertebrate animals in science. We have learnt about the phylum invertebrates and practised classifying unusual new species.

We have had a big push on learning the meaning of factors, multiples and finding different types.

From next Friday we will begin weekly times tables tests. Your child will be given a timetable and multiplication sheet to revise from. The best way is to write out and say the times table, then practise it on TTRockstars.

NEXT WEEK
