This week, we have been focusing on division in Maths, using visual representations to help us understand division and remainders. In English, we have worked on our comprehension skills and talked in detail about how to improve our skills in this area. In Art, we continued to work on our technical skills producing some impressive pieces of perspective drawing. In Geography, we learnt about the human and natural causes of wildfires and categorized weather conditions from safe to dangerous.

Have a conversation about what they are learning.



Encourage your child to read around topics
