THIS AND NEXT WEEK

In Storytime Phonics we have learnt about the following digraphs: 'au,' 'ph,' 'wh', 'ou' (as in out) and 'ir.' Do go through these with your child and ask them if they can think of a word which includes that sound. We also completed a phoneme spotter for 'ay.'

On our Daily Mile we think about the sound of the day and the children think of words for example- Autumn, phone, Whiffy Wilson, shout and girl. We have also started to think of the alternative sounds and spellings too. In Science/Geography we are continuing learning about weather symbols used in forecasts. Next week we will start our Caring for our World topic.

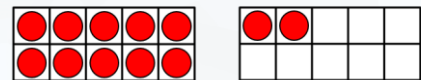
Draw an outline around 10 then count the items.
