THIS AND NEXT WEEK

In Storytime Phonics we have learnt the following sounds: ay, a-e, ea/e-e/ey, i-e/ie, and ow this week. I have been very impressed by the words that the children have suggested which contain those phonemes. Please continue to revise the sounds when you read with your child.

We have focussed on common exception words and the children have completed their first (simple) dictation using the words 'she, is, and, go was, the a, girl, away, said, he' so please encourage your child to spell these correctly. In English we have also looked at adding 'ed' to words in the past tense.

Our Science and Geography topics are linked as we think about ways to care for our world, whilst also looking at extreme weather in different countries.
