We have really enjoyed exploring our new topic in English - The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe. There's something magical about Narnia which we have just begun learning about! The children have made inferences about the characters by examining the explicit and implicit details about them, and written some excellent setting descriptions.

In Maths we have been looking at factors and multiples, learning what they are and investigating ways to help us find them.


