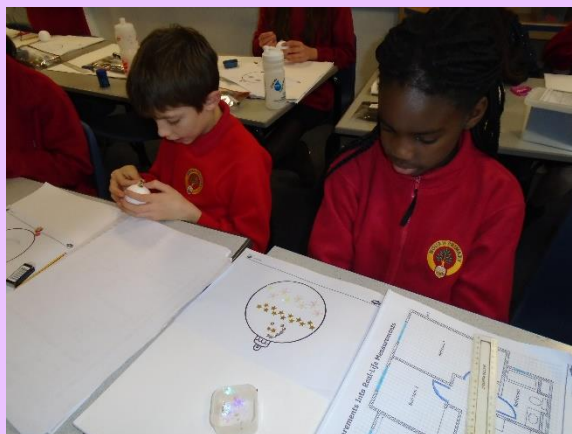
HOW YOU CAN HELP:
