


Fri.	<p><u>To write to inform</u></p> <p>Watch the video of the Little Shoe Maker again. https://www.literacyshed.com/littleshoemaker.html</p> <p>Task: Write an explanation for how to make magic shoes.</p> <p>Remember what you have learnt about writing to inform: organise you writing using headings and paragraphs, write facts rather than opinion. You then draw/copy the image across onto your blank piece of paper, focusing on one square at a time, until the entire image has been transferred.</p> <p>Select an image of your own choosing and practice drawing it using the grid method.</p> <p>Tip: the more detailed the picture, the harder it will be to transfer.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>
